

Saddlewood is Offering a Three Day Thanksgiving Weekend Camp

Ride your favourite Saddlewood horse or pony again this FALL

Saddlewood will be offering only one weekend camp this spring **for campers who have been to Saddlewood before.**

A bus will pick up Toronto and area campers at 6:00 pm at York Mills Plaza (corner of York Mills and Bayview Ave.) on Friday, October 6, 2017 and will return campers to York Mills on Monday, October 9, 2017 at 5:00 pm. Campers not using the bus should arrive at Saddlewood around 7:00 pm on Friday, October 6, and be picked up on Monday, October 9 at 3:00 pm.

Bring your sleeping bag and pillow, long pants and a sweater, a warm jacket, rainwear and of course your riding clothes, (helmet, boots, and safety vest if you have one). You do not need a lot of clothes but make sure you bring something warm and something waterproof. Bring old clothes because you will spend most of your time in and around the barn and the horses.

Campers will have six riding lessons over the course of the weekend. In most cases campers will be able to ride and care for their favourite Saddlewood horse or pony. Riding is the main focus of the weekend.
